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STUDENT BODY PROFILE *(3,238 students)*

DIVERSE 51.5% White, 22.7% African American, 19.8% Hispanic, 2.7% Asian, 3.3% Other

SOCIOECONOMICALLY STRATIFIED Students in all income brackets; nearly 25% of MP students live below the poverty line or receive some form of public assistance.

HOMELESS OR TRANSITIONAL STUDENTS Fluctuating population approaches 100+ per year.

EXCEPTIONAL CHILDREN 7.1% of students have special needs including hearing or visual impairment and/or occupational needs.

INTERNATIONAL 50 countries represented, 46 languages spoken, and 692 students have a native language other than English.

ACADEMICS

- Class of 2024-70% attending a 4-year college, 17% Work or Military, 13% Community College or Technical School.
- Myers Park offers **30 Advanced Placement** courses and over 80 **International Baccalaureate** classes grade 9-12 with 36 International Baccalaureate Diploma Courses for grade 11-12.
- The Class of 2024 had 155 full International Baccalaureate Diploma Students. 80% of these students earned their IB Diploma. MPHS students outperformed the world average in 7 different subjects and met the district and world averages in the remaining subjects.
- Students in Advanced Placement (AP) classes consistently scored 4's and 5's on the AP exams.
- In addition, the curriculum provides broad vocational offerings, including Career/Technical education, apprenticeships, career intern programs, and the Occupational Course of Study for Exceptional Education Students.
- AP, IB, and Honors enrollment **have experienced year over year growth** in every racial and ethnic group.
- The Class of 2024 has a mean score of 1270 on the SAT and 23.7 Composite on the ACT.
- Myers Park students consistently win competitive awards such as National Merit Scholarships, and National Achievement Awards, along with prestigious scholarships including UNC's Morehead-Cain, UVA's Jefferson, Duke's AB, NC State's Park, UGA's Presidential, South Carolina's McNair Scholarship and Davidson's Belk Scholarship.

ATHLETICS & CO-CURRICULAR PROGRAMS

- The campus boasts over **100 clubs** that serve as service, academic, student interest and competitive organizations.
- Myers Park supports 37 junior varsity and varsity sports for men and women including club sports.
- ~30% of the student body participates in the athletic program.
- **2 State Championships** were won last year. All our varsity teams made the NCHSAA playoffs.
- 24 students won Scholastic Art Awards; 10 pieces won Honorable Mention, 9 won a Silver Key and 5 won Gold individual awards.
- Visual Arts Students participate in exhibitions such as Scholastic Art & Writing Festival, NCASA Art Showcase and IB Visual Arts Exhibition.
